

FAQ about the Coronavirus.

For students, guests:

1. Will my medical expenses be reimbursed if I become infected with the coronavirus?
When you have your health insurance through International Insurances verzekeringen, your health insurance will cover the costs that are medically necessary. *Please contact us* if you would like more information about the cover.

In case of emergency call the emergency number, which you find on your insurance card/information letter.

When you have your **health insurance not through International Insurance** we advise you to check the coverage overview and terms from your insurance company and see if they cover the medical costs for the Coronavirus.

Note: There are insurance companies, for example Swiss Care, who don't cover medical costs as the WHO (https://www.who.int/health-topics/coronavirus#tab=tab_1) qualifies this coronavirus as an epidemic or pandemic. So in this situation, the Coronavirus is qualified as an epidemic and pandemic, there is no medical cover for the Coronavirus.
